CHURCH & BUILDING UPDATE

We celebrated the opening of our church building on March 6th, with our first service and meal! Several Churches in the Calvary network came to encourage us on our first day, and we were overrun with people and support!

Since then, we have been working hard to make this building even more beautiful and functional.

Last month we received a team from Tijuana that stayed in our church building. They donated twelve mattresses, and we added a kitchen area where they could cook for themselves. With the help from the team, we were able to put up several walls and paint a few murals throughout the church!

We now have two classrooms, three accessible

bathrooms, a separation between the front entrance and sanctuary, and a storage area. There is still much left to do and paint, but it has been incredible to see this church building go from an open garage to a beautiful place where the people of Stone Island can worship the Lord.

RESTORATION

For the past few months, I have been declining in my physical and mental health, so I decided to take a short vacation with Jesus. I spent three days in Mazatlán, hearing from Him and finding out how I can continue in ministry in a healthier manner. I also was able to visit a doctor, and I am receiving treatment for my physical health, but will need further testing to know exactly how to proceed.

While I am still in a process with God to know how to best steward my mental health, I am much better aware of what I need.

NEW OPPORTUNITIES

There has been a lot happening in Stone Island, and I am so thankful to be a part of everything God is doing here!

In Mazatlán, there is a young woman who works with the YWAM base and runs a small school for kids in a specific low-income area. I was informed that she was looking for an art teacher for the children, and being interested in the position, had a meeting with her. After this, I decided to take the position and will be teaching once a week for one hour with a group of children from three to nine. There are several things that I need to complete before I can teach, such as apply for a background check and create a more in-depth lesson plan; but I am happy to say that I will start teaching art soon!
