Zacchaeus is Forgiven

Zacchaeus was a very rich man. He was also very short. He wanted to see Jesus, but there were so many people crowded around Jesus, that Zacchaeus couldn't see Jesus. So Zacchaeus climbed up in a tree. When Jesus came by, He told Zacchaeus to come down and they ale together at Zacchaeus' house. Zacchaeus told Jesus he was sorry for the sinful things he had done and Jesus forgave him.
